Here is what **Kevin Rudd** said about the UN reform. He used to be **the Prime Minister of Australia**: *"I remain a life-long UN supporter, advocate and optimist. But **the time for deep UN reform is now. Otherwise, the UN will, in the decades ahead, not die, but quietly fade away,** the facade of a once grand building but where, on closer inspection, little of substance actually happens anymore. Also, **Michael Møller**, director-general of the United Nations Geneva office is for the reform. He was asked: **Secretary-General António Guterres has strongly defended the need for reform within the U.N. What specifically needs to change?**

He replied. *"**Pretty much everything.** This is an organization created 70 years ago that has not entirely kept pace with rapid changes, realities, and big existential challenges such as climate change, migration, and health. We have to change our peace and security mechanisms, the way we do development, our internal management, and back-office functions."*

He also said. *"We have to return to a rules-based world with ethics and moral codes that we can agree to. They do not have to be those that were agreed upon 70 years ago, because the world is changing, and we have to change with it."*

As growing concerns over climate change, human rights abuses, and mass migration intensify pressure for U.N. reform, Michael Møller, director-general of its Geneva office in Switzerland, insists that multilateralism is all the more vital.

Many people are pointing out the fact that the UN is in danger of becoming irrelevant. The time to reform the UN is NOW.

How can we achieve this huge world-changing UN reform?

And the people who want to get more involved, and there will be millions of those; they can print posters, create FB groups and promote this campaign with many different ways.

The best part is that the politicians won't have to do that much either. All they would have to do is to declare on their social media that they will support the UN reform. And then vote for it when the time comes. Minimal effort required!

IMPORTANT: The beauty of this plan is that **it gives the politicians an EXCUSE to say**; "Sorry my political party, sorry military machine, sorry big money, sorry lobbyist, etc. I know that some of you might be against the UN reform, but I am FORCED by The People Power to support the reform. If I don't support it, I will not get elected/re-elected."

This gives the politicians a great way out; an excuse to disobey all these influences that they typically may have to obey. Don't you agree that this is a clever way to give politicians an excuse to support this idea?

Celebrities, sports stars, musician and other influential and famous people, businesses and organizations are the UTMOST critical part of this plan!

The principle idea is to have these celebrities and other influential people and organizations to introduce this plan to their fans and the media. That's all it takes to get the ball rolling!

Just think about how easily the above stars could energize their friends, fan base and the media to support this idea with a few comments about it in the media. Other celebrities around the world would follow suit and spread the word to their fans.

Again the best part is that these celebrities would not have to do that much.

All they have to do is to encourage their fans to start sending emails to elected officials. They can do this with a few comments in media, Twitter and FB posts. **How could ANY decent celebrity say not to this?**

The plan requires relatively little money or effort to put it in motion. We all know the power that the celebrities have over their fans and media. With the help of celebrities, this idea could spread around the world in no time, and people would start emailing to their government and elected officials.

The above text is the central part of this plan. Very simple, yet very effective. How could transforming the world and achieving world peace get any easier than this?

Practically in every country, people are fed up and disgusted with their politicians and ineffective UN. They are sick and tired of constant wars, uncertainty, refugees and the US, Russia, and China keeping the cold war hot.

People are ready for a change. This plan gives all the people in the world an EASY opportunity to FORCE their politicians to support the UN reform so that WE THE PEOPLE can together create a true paradise this planet can become.

I do realize that to get this going will take some effort, but as long as we can get the people of the world behind this idea, the rest will work out by itself.

WE HAVE TO MAKE SURE THAT CELEBRITIES AND PEOPLE UNDERSTAND THAT IT'S VERY IMPORTANT TO KEEP THE PRESSURE ON AS LONG AS IT TAKES. This is not one-off.

Once people of the world realize that this idea REALLY is doable and that it actually CAN change the world, they will support it with open arms. This movement will grow like a wildfire.

Main points

1. We will need to get a group of people together, which will hash out the details, as for how this plan will be executed.
2. We get celebrities, music and sports stars and other influential people, organizations, and businesses committed to this email and social media revolution.

3. Once we launch: These people and organizations energize their fanbase, media and their famous and influential friends and colleagues around the world to get involved in this revolution.
4. People around the world start emailing to their elected officials about the need for reforming the UN.
5. There will be a huge PR and advertising campaign to support this in all the different media.
6. This pressure is kept up as long it takes to get at least 60% of nations of the world to support the UN reform. (We must emphasize to people that we **MUST** not get lazy or complacent, we **MUST** keep the pressure up until we get results.)
7. After we have enough countries supporting the UN reform, then these countries will demand a vote in the UN.
8. When the gavel hits the desk in the UN, and the NUN laws' become affect; all the wars are practically speaking over. **We have world peace!**
9. This is the start of the New World Order (NWO).
10. The NUN will create a true paradise on earth for ALL the people in the world.

Who will run this movement?

I can see three different ways to run this movement.

1. Some peace organization takes over and runs it.
2. We start a new organization for this endeavor.
3. We hire an international advertising/PR company to run the whole thing.

I personally think the most efficient and the best all the way around would be to hire a big international advertising/PR company to take care of the whole thing. They have the personnel, know-how, and connections around the world to make this happen.

They can easily set up and mind websites and social media sites, produce the media kits and print/film ads for all the different media, line up the celebrities and keep this effort going with PR and ads, etc. as long as it takes to get the UN reform done.

How is this movement and ad campaign going to be funded?

I am sure that after I find some influential key person(s), who has enough clout to get for example Sir Bob Geldof and some other similar celebrity peace activist onboard with this, then the money will not be an issue at all.

Regardless of how this movement will be run, it will cost millions of dollars. But that is a very small price to pay for world peace. Don't you agree?

When the key person(s) and the celebrities explain what we are up to, to the super-rich philanthropists and different foundations and businesses, the money will pour in. Who would say no to an opportunity to be part of something this crucial for the world and humankind? **There just isn't anything bigger and more important than saving the world.**

Below is a more detailed explanation of the direction of how the UN could be reformed

- **Every nation in the world is allowed to make its own rules and laws** regarding political views, governing system, official religions, etc. But the NUN will create detailed rules and laws about how all the countries of the world must treat their citizens.

For example, it will make rulings about child labor, girls' school issues, forced religious teachings, forced marriage, genital mutilations, economical slavery, etc.

Also, every country is obligated to provide the basic needs to its people. Such as basic education and basic healthcare for all, food and shelter, etc. (What basic means varies from country to country depending on how poor the country is. These services don't have to be 100% free, but affordable enough so that most people can afford them, and poorest of the poor would get them for free.) And of course as these countries get wealthier, then these basic services will get better as well.

And every person on earth will have such fundamental freedoms as political assembly, opposition, religion, movement, sexual orientation, freedom of speech, free media, equal justice, etc.

These laws will be strictly enforced. If any country is not willing to obey them, then the NUN can fine or place a sanction on this country or on its leaders. If these measures are not enough, then the NUN is obligated to in worst case to remove unruly leaders, set up a temporary government and then the NUN will help to run this country until it's stabilized.

If a country is too poor to take care of its citizens, then the NUN is obligated to help that country until it is capable of taking care of its people.

The lack of basic necessities in many poor countries is not because of the lack of money, but because the leaders of these countries steal the money and they often also steal foreign aid. The NUN will have a mandate to get rid of tyrants that steal aid, or monies that belong to the nations.

- **The NUN will be the world's police.** It will deal with any situation with neutral stand and common sense values. The NUN will be obligated to protect every member nation from any violent attack from another country. Also, once the attack has been stopped, then the leaders and generals of the attacking country will be removed and tried in the International Courts. **This will practically end all the wars the very moment this law becomes effective.**
- The NUN will hire armed force coalitions from the countries that now have large armed forces for any warlike situations, or remove unruly heads of states. **All nations in the NUN will pay for their fair share for these operations.**

- If a person starts shooting a gun around from his balcony or beats his family, the local police has the absolute power to remove that person who is a danger to his family or fellow citizens. Also if parents starve their children, they will be prosecuted for it. **Why the leaders of many countries are not governed by the same law as its citizens are?**
- The NUN will be obligated by law, by any means necessary to get rid of any world leaders, political party, religious group, terrorist group or armed forces, which for example starves, imprisons people for political, LGBT, religious reasons, or kills or mistreats their people in any way. **This law alone would stop people suppression around the world.**
- The NUN will take a leading role in worldwide arms reduction. The goal is that in about 30 to 50 years there are no more nukes, chemical- or biological arms in the world.
- Even though the US, Russia, China, and some other small “rebellious” countries will not give up their armed forces for a long time to come, but **ONLY THE NUN HAS THE RIGHT TO DECLARE A WAR AGAINST A NATION OR A GROUP OF PEOPLE.** Of course, every nation has the right to defend itself against any attack, and the NUN is obligated to help them.
- **No individuals or groups in the NUN can start any armed operations on their own. All sanctions and armed responses will be voted in the NUN between the member nations.**
- If one of these big countries; the US, China or Russia would start a military action against another nation, or against their own people, then they would be declaring war against EVERY member nation in the NUN. This kind of a situation, of course, would be a complicated issue to deal with, but I am sure that by isolating this country, very severe and immediate economic sanctions and penalties would bring this country back in line.

After the NUN is in power it will be very difficult and unlike for anything like this to happen. Just think about it; how could any country, regardless of how powerful it is, survive if the whole world is against it? And also the two other powerful nations would be against it. **There is no way that any major country would be stupid enough to start hostilities against the whole united world.**

Also in the future, people around the world would understand that they are part of the solution and they would stop traveling and buying anything from a country that is causing problems. No country could afford to be isolated. Anything like this to happen is very unlike.

Of course, also some other countries with major armed force will be hesitant to give up their arms. But in the future, as they realize that the peaceful world is also much better for them, they will start reducing them by not buying new arms as the old ones get decommissioned.

When the NUN is in charge, then most of the smaller countries will soon realize that they don't need a big military force anymore. They will have small armed forces to be able to protect themselves against possible riots, terrorism, etc. By having small armed forces they can save a lot of money.

Any border disputes between countries, independence movements, etc. will be resolved in the International Courts and the NUN will make sure that the nations adhere to these decisions.

There will be no more need for freedom fighters in any country because any person or a group could challenge the current leaders in open and fair elections.

- From the text above it may seem to some that the NUN will be some kind of a military monster. But **that's not the case at all**. Just the fact alone that the NUN must by law to protect any nation that is attacked, or remove any tyrants who hurt their citizens will **work as a deterrent** because these leaders don't want to go to prison.

Today many tyrants know that the other nations cannot do anything about them, and they keep on killing their own people and putting innocent people in prisons. Other countries scold them, but that's about it.

Let's look at the Myanmar situation where Rohingya Muslim are being prosecuted, killed and displaced. Now the leaders of Myanmar give the world just lip service about this human catastrophe and ethnic cleansing. What could they do, if the Thai army would come from the east? Chinese from the

north. Russians would cover the air and the US navy would land from the sea? Myanmar's armed forces would give up without a shot.

The NUN would remove all the generals and leaders of this country and have them tried on courts for the crimes they have committed.

Most likely this will **work out so that the NUN would never have to use any military power because the NUN mandates and laws alone work as a deterrent.** When the NUN is in power there is no way any nation can win a war they start, because they are going to be fighting against every member nation in the world. So in the future, no sane leader of a country would start a war, because there is NO way they could get away with it. The new laws will dictate that the leaders of a rebellious country and their generals will end up in a prison.

- The security council will be abolished, in which five nations that won the Second World War rule the world. These countries don't have to adhere to the same rules as the rest of the nations do, because of the veto rights. They are China, France, Russia, the United Kingdom, and the United States.
- **An important part of the NUN is a new value system.** A new value system will be created for the NUN, which is closely monitored so that all nations adhere to them as they interact, vote etc. in the NUN. These values will be based on common sense and good normal values and ethics.
- Any backroom deals, pressure, corruption, vote buying or bullying etc. in the NUN will be totally unacceptable. Now some nations threaten to cut their UN fees or aid to countries that are against them. That craziness stops now! If a country is caught doing any of the above-mentioned things, there will be a penalty. If misconduct is severe; the penalty could be a hefty monetary fine, isolation from the NUN decision making and this country's NUN representatives could be fired. **All of the NUN representatives of any nation will be closely vetted to make sure that they fit the NUN values, rules and regulations.**
- The NUN will be in charge and takes a leading role in major natural and man-made catastrophes. It's much more efficient that if there is one central point that coordinates the help effort. Also, the NUN will make rulings over

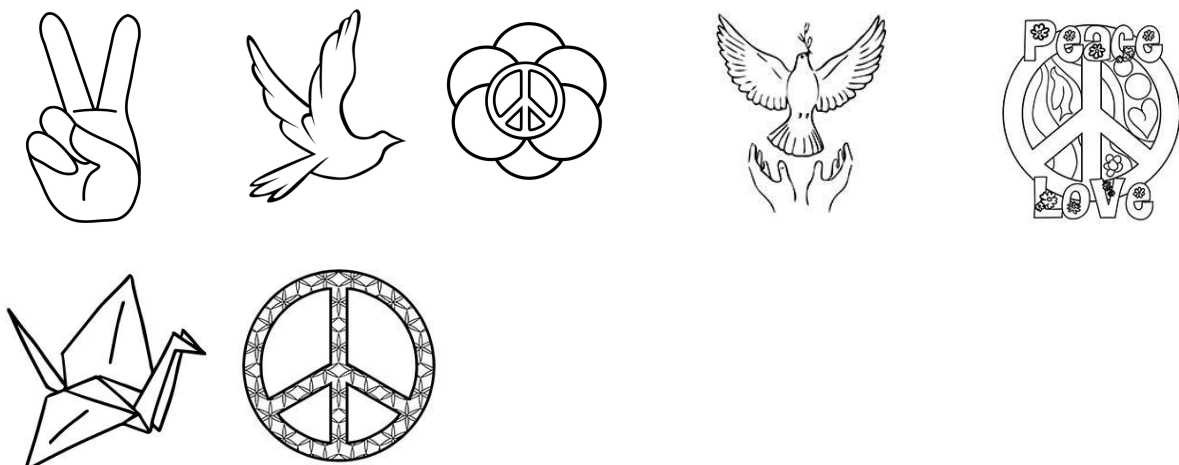

First off, we don't have to get every persons' support in the world, but if we get the support of the people who are for peace, nature and animal welfare, saving this planet, etc. that alone might be enough. Worldwide there are countless environmental, animal, nature, freedom, equal right, developing nation aid and other similar organizations with millions upon millions of members. These people have been trying to help and save the world for decades. They are craving for a real doable way to save this planet. Will the NUN will use boycotts?

According to Wikipedia, The United States imposed the first sanctions against South Korea in the 1950s. The UN Security Council has passed a number of resolutions since North Korea's first nuclear test in 2006. **We have been playing this very dangerous nuclear game with North Korea since 2006!**

This is the main problem with our current system. We don't end these kinds of situations at the beginning. We let them go for years. And the reason for this is that only the US has had the powers to force North Korea to stop testing. But the US presidents haven't done anything because **they are more concerned about their popularity numbers and legacy than anything else**. They know that, if they try to do something, the situation may turn into a huge mess, and that is why they have stayed clear of North Korea.

Now the Trump administration it at least trying to solve this situation. Let's hope it will lead to a peaceful resolution. One big hindrance has been this: *A total of 49 countries violated United Nations sanctions on North Korea to varying degrees between March 2014 and September 2017, the Institute for Science and International Security said. That includes North Korea's top trading partner, China, as well as Germany, Brazil, India, and France.* Also, Russia among others has lately been shipping stuff to North Korea.

THE POINT IS that the North Korean situation would have been resolved a long time ago if countries and companies have not been violating the sanctions. All these years the people of North Korea have been suffering, while the top brass lives in luxury.

The NUN would act immediately when there is any violation of the new international laws. And it would have the powers to **severely penalize** any company or country

that violates any sanctions. If the NUN would punish a company so severe that it would go out of business. This would work as a deterrent, and other companies would take notice.

POTENTIALLY this situation in North Korea could lead a nuclear war, and hardly anybody seems to care. Should that happen, the party would be over. The whole world would tailspin into a deep depression, which would lead to all kinds of upheaval. Mass unemployment, huge mass immigration, refugees, etc. would lead to chaos all around the world.

- At least 70 conflicts involve non-state actors, a historic high.
- An estimated 126,059 people were killed in conflicts in 2014, the largest annual number of fatalities since the Rwandan genocide in 1994.
- The past five years have seen worsening trends across conflict indicators: more wars, more people killed and civilians increasingly targeted.

And you thought that the world was getting better, safer and that there was less suffering in the world. And this is just war-related problems. On top of this, think about climate change, animal extinction, pollution, and other environmental issues, refugees and the last but not certainly the least worrisome problem; individual, the national and total global debt crisis that is going to hit the fan sooner or later.

Can you even imagine what will happen when the world's economic machine grinds to a very painful halt? (And it will if we don't stop living on credit.) When there is mass unemployment around the world, and refugees and immigrants are willing to work for less money. Many people will be out of work if there is no longer a need for arms

Many arms manufacturers will find new products to develop and to build. So that when the situation clears, it will be easy for people to return back to their own country. The refugees are NOT allowed to get out and start a mass exodus. Eventually, they will return to their own country.

Actually, in the future, there is very little possibility that Syria kind of situation will happen again because wars will be history. There could be some natural disasters, famine etc. that could create mass refugees. These issues will also be dealt with by the NUN, swiftly and fairly. All the UN member nations will pay for these operations.

What if the NUN starts meddling with the internal issues of its member countries?

That will be prohibited by internal laws in the NUN. There will be very clear laws and regulation as to what the NUN can and cannot do. All the member nations will vote on these laws.

The NUN will be in charge of only **MAJOR** international issues and issues that affect all of us. For example the climate change, whale hunting, pollution, wars, terrorism, etc. Big issues like these must be decided in an environment that is non-political, non-religious and non-bias in any way. Only then we can find real lasting solutions to all major issues we are now facing and will face. Now every issue in the UN is power

and political struggle. Nothing is ever resolved with common sense and the way it is good for the world or the people.

The NUN must have the authority to enforce these laws and to penalize the countries or companies, which are not obeying them. Nowadays many nations and companies find ways to cheat on international treaties, so what good are they, if they cannot be enforced?

The NUN may have to enforce laws on a sovereign nation. For example, let's say that we realize that the Brazilian rainforest really are the lungs of the earth, and they must stop cutting it down. Whatever the excuses Brazil may use, it's not going to be enough to justify that we jeopardize the well being of the world. This is such a huge issue for the whole world that the NUN must go to Brazil and stop cutting down the rainforest if the Brazilian government is not able to stop it. Or the NUN will help Brazil to stop it.

In cases like this, when rainforest and other HUGE areas of the land are cleared for agriculture they are mostly done by big greedy multinational corporations. This happens ever increasing speed in many countries around the world. Soybean fields in South America are one big culprit. They always have the same excuse; people need food. But that's a lie. If the governments in those counties would not steal all the money and businesses would pay at least a minimum wage, the people would have enough money to buy food etc. It's the big greedy businesses that are the worst offenders in these issues.

When it comes to meddling with the member nations, the **European Union is the opposite of what the NUN will be.** EU controls almost everything in the member countries. The EU even had a law that Cucumbers cannot be too crooked. That led to huge waste, because of a big part of the harvest had to be thrown out. That law was repealed, but every year the EU keeps on adding new totally useless laws and rules. In time the EU will gain **total control** of the member nations.

Many people are against centralizing power into one institution

We need to centralize the MAJOR decisions about the world to one neutral power. People are afraid of this because in the past this has led to dictatorships; like it did with Hitler, Mao, and Stalin. It's impossible that the NUN would become a police state

or dictatorship. Those days are long gone, but people still have this knee jerk reaction to this whenever centralized power comes up.

European Union and the United States are centralized powers, and people seem to be okay with them. One HUGE advantage over other centralized powers is that the NUN will have is that **it will be lead by professionals without political wrangling or religious ideology.** All decisions will be made for the good of the world, by people who are professionals in each matter they work on. Just stop to think about that for a moment; the NUN will have professional staff, not big ego politicians who rarely know nothing but hot to play political games.

What is your warning to the tyrants of the world?

When the new laws become effective in the NUN, then there is no longer a possibility of any tyrant of getting off free – no more getting “golden handshake” and comfortable retirement. After the gavel hits the desk in the UN headquarters and the NUN is born, then it will be obligated to remove and prosecute these tyrants.

When the NUN takes over an unruly country, its citizens will feel safe to start giving testimony on all kinds of old crimes. Lower ranking people will be promised deals if they can indicate the higher ups. Generally speaking, the NUN will mainly go after the higher level government, police and armed forces leaders. Lower ranking members were in most cases ordered by their superiors to commit these crimes.

Murder never gets old. Even old crimes will be investigated and already retired ex-tyrants and army chiefs are not going to be safe. There will not be bail. These tyrants and generals will be waiting for the trial in the same prisons they threw their opponents and innocents people. All their ill-gained property will be confiscated and bank accounts will be frozen. Even the leaders and army chiefs’ families and close up friends and business partners properties will be confiscated if they are determined to be gotten illegally.

All unexplainable wealth will be confiscated. Many accountants, close friends, and lower ranking people will aid the investigations to save their skin. So it will be very easy to find the hidden bank accounts and to prove financial crimes.

How would these the legal proceedings be conducted?

Of course, the NUN and the International Courts will determine that, but I would conduct them in the actual countries, not in Hage. First there will be a through evidence collection period, witnesses are lined up and after all that is done, the temporary court is set up. Most judges should be from that particular country. Of course, there needs also be international judges presence, but it's better if the country's own people deal with their own criminals.

The laws as how to the tyrants and generals etc. are tried on, should be simple and clear, so that they will not be able to hire, with the money they have stolen from their own country a "dream team" to defend themselves, so that the trial will last for years on end.

In most cases, it will be very clear what crimes they have committed, so this process will be fast. Also, they should not be prosecuted for every single crime or murder they have committed, because it will take a too long time to gather all the evidence to prove each individual case. If a tyrant is found guilty of a few murders and financial crimes that will be enough to put him away for life. All the other crimes that he is suspected of committing could be read in the court so that the victims and families of the victims, will get closure. Idea is that this process is speedy so that the country can start moving on.

Of course, all accused will get a fair trial, but not like it's in many western countries where just a little doubt will get you off. Often criminals have more rights than victims, police or prosecutors; the prosecutor has a lot tougher job to prove the case, than the defense. After the country is liberated, culprits are in prison, properties are confiscated, then this country can start rebuilding itself with new leaders and laws.

How should independence issues be handled?

I think it would **be very healing for the world** if areas of some countries that have been forcefully taken could become independent, or join back to their original motherland. The NUN will come up with the rules and laws regarding all of these border and independence movement issues. These laws will be voted in the NUN so that every nation is part of putting these laws together. International Courts will hear these cases, and the NUN will enforce them.

These laws must be based on common sense, for example, was the area taken by force in a war? How long ago? How well has this area been integrated into the

current country? Would breaking it off cause major upheaval to the people who live there? Do the people of that area want to leave this country, or is it just some small group of people? Is it an ethnic group that wants to be independent? What are the grounds for breaking off?

I would think that the start of World War I, or II could serve a good cut off point because they both were major wars that affected most of the nations in the world. (WWI was 100 years ago, maybe that's a convenient cut off point?). If some area was taken way before that, it's now part of the new nation, but of course, there could be some special cases. And any major group of people could take their case to the International Courts.

What will happen, if we don't reform the UN?

This may give you some idea of it: China's president said in a speech in October 2017 that China's goal is to tighten the armed forces and civilian life more together; sounds bad whatever that means? Also, their goal is to be the world leader and to have a world class armed forces between the years 2035-2050. This means that Russia, Japan, India, and the US must keep up with China. The arms race is going to continue forever. The US is starting a Space Force. India and Pakistan are currently in the brink of war. **We must stop this utter craziness!**

China and Russia are building their armed forces like there is no tomorrow. Russia is supposedly scared of the NATO waging war against it and taking it over, and Europe is preparing for a Russian attack. How crazy is this?

Are these leaders really this crazy, or are they just playing a game of uncertainty and fear? It's very hard for me to believe that the Russians really fear that NATO will wage war at it, or that the Chinese feel that they will need all those arms for actual combat. **Could all this be because politicians and our leaders can hold on the power the easiest when times are uncertain, and the constant fear of war is present?**

No country in the world can even dream about waging a war against the US, Russia or China; simply because there are so many nukes, it's impossible for that to happen. Is it possible that the US, Russia and/or China could have a limited war? They all know that even a limited war could easily escalate to a full-blown nuclear war. So because of all this, **I believe that the wars, conflicts and the arms race is happening**

because the leaders and politicians are in the pockets of the arms manufacturers and dealers.

In the US the arms lobby is very powerful. Normally Republicans and Democrats hardly ever agree on any issues, but not so surprisingly most wars they agree on. Could this be because they both are so heavily lobbied on by arms manufacturers?

It really is beyond all my imagination that in this century we are still fearful of each other and spend a lot of money on arms, wars and all kinds of conflicts. I would understand this kind of thinking, if we were living in the 1800s, but not today. So the question is; are our leaders' mental states based on the thinking of the 1800s, or is the deep state, arms manufacturers and dealers who are in charge here?

No matter what the answer is, **we must break free from this utter craziness, before it destroys us.** Our leaders will wake up when a major war breaks out, or when the rising sea level starts washing the toes of the Statue of the Liberty in New York. Then they will start blaming the old administrations for these problems. Even then, they will not be able to reach in any kind of consensus, because politics is like that. Our current UN is not capable of ruling the world; we must reform it, and give it the keys to rule the world before it's too late.

If we add the cost of all wars, armed conflicts, freedom fighting, national guards, armies, police force, private guards etc. I am quite confident to say, that close to 30% of all the monies we have in the world go these areas. And if we count the cost of rebuilding bombed out countries, hospitalization of the people etc., who knows how much all that actually cost.

The United States has spent nearly \$6 trillion on wars that directly contributed to the deaths of around 500,000 people since the 9/11 attacks of 2001. This has created an unfathomable amount of human suffering, on which we cannot put any price.

What kind of people will the NUN draw to itself?

I am sure that there already are a lot of good dedicated people in the UN, but the UN has become bloated and some people want to work there just for the fame and for advancing their careers. The UN has its share of power hungry, big ego, narcissistic people who are there for the wrong reason. These people enjoy constant crisis and upheaval They love to be in the limelight pretending of solving yet another major crisis. They never do resolve anything, but just bandage it for the moment. But I don't

blame the current UN personnel. I am sure they are trying their best under the rules and regulations that are now in.

When we set up a new governing model in the NUN, in which high values, morals, and ethics govern every decision that is being made. What kind of people will that draw to the NUN? Would a person with bad values thrive in that kind of an environment? I don't think so.

This is an essential part of the UN reform. The NUN will draw a different breed of people into it, as it did before.

In every government around the world, and also in the UN, there already are thousands of these people who feel that working for the people of a nation is their calling. I call them invisible mass. They are the core of any workforce that keeps things together, but they never get the credit for it. In politics or in business, it's the loud mouth, big ego leaders who steal the glory that these people should have.

This invisible mass would be willing to work for free for the NUN because they feel that dedicated to the wellbeing of the world. But in the NUN they will be properly compensated and also they will get the glory for running the NUN. These people can have their own political and religious views, but they will be smart enough that they will leave them at the coat check when they start making decisions in the NUN. This is what kind of people the NUN will draw to its doors.

This is why I am very confident that getting the UN reformed would not be that difficult of a task that it may seem to many people. **With super dedicated people, new values and ethics, it will be a breeze.** The UN already has a lot of dedicated people who would love to reform and work for the NUN.

Just think about what kind of energy would this create in the NUN! The huge issues that we now argue about for years without getting any meaningful results, would be resolved in a few meetings. People would work tirelessly and with full of energy because they see a clear result for their efforts, and most importantly; they see how the world gets better by the month. **With this kind of energy and cooperation between people, the NUN would solve the most major problems we now face, in a few years.**

Before the UN has not been able to solve any major problems simply because they always are watered down compromises that protect some powers and countries.

They are NEVER done ONLY for the good and well being of the people and this world. **Just stop to think about the power of a decision, which is done ONLY for the good and the wellbeing of the people and this world. How powerful would that be!**

There will be a different BREED of people in charge of the NUN. The breed, whose foremost concern is what's good for the word and its people. They know that what's good for the people and the world itself, is good for the corporations and nations too.

What can We the People do for our communities and countries?

We The People have become too docile and dependent on governments. **We The People must be part of the solution.**

What good is world peace for us, if we are not able to walk fear-free in our cities and neighborhoods?

We The People must take control of our cities. What good is it for you, if there is peace in Syria, but at the same time you cannot walk to a local market because you might be beaten, robbed on knife point or molested? Or you are scared that your child may be lured into using drugs or getting into a gang etc.? We must take our neighborhoods back from hooligans, gangs, and criminals with the help of local police.

As we start reforming the UN, we must also reform our own lives, neighborhoods, cities, and countries. Then and only then we will be able to say that we have a true WORLD PEACE and we are leading good lives. We just cannot expect the UN reform, or our politicians to take care of fixing all the world's problems, **we MUST be a BIG part of the solution, and we also must be willing to DO OUR PART** reforming our own lives, families, and neighborhoods!

What is important in life. How to deal with one's emotions and

feelings. what means to be content in life. Dangers of drugs and alcohol etc. In other words, it will teach youngsters how to live a good healthy life.

Life skills and good value system are important bases for a successful life. When young people are taught these kinds of things, they are much less likely to end up criminals, addicts or unemployed. We must change our education systems to teach our kids more of these life skills. If they have these skills down, then they will be more successful and happy regardless of how low their education level is.

If you will just stop to think about your own life for a moment. **How would have it been, if you had an opportunity to study in a school where they taught skills like above?** If you would have learned to like or even love yourself, you would be fearless in front of other people, you would have solid self-confidence and you would have a high degree of self worth-would, you would have kept your body and mind healthy, you would have had enough balls to follow your own path and dream, you would have not stayed in toxic relationships and would not have abused drugs or alcohol etc.? How would your life be? At least mine would have been more exciting, freer, interesting and probably even more successful.

Actually, because we don't have the skills mentioned above we live a mediocre existence. If you would love yourself, be free to perform anything without fear, would not be introvert or shy, (you are shy because you don't have self-confidence) would be able to make friends anywhere and would have a solid self-confidence on your work skills, you would not have self-doubt and fears, then your life would be good.

Having these learnable skills is how you have happiness, contentment, and success in your life.

Have you ever met a happy/content person who has fears, is overly shy, don't have self-confidence, hates him or herself, etc. No, you have not! And the same goes for a person who is greedy, selfish, envious, bad, criminal, mean, violent, etc.
