Many companies and other institutions that benefit from these pandemics, wars and turmoil want to milk them as long as possible for their benefits.

What if the war in Ukraine spreads to Europe? What if China attacks Taiwan? What if some terrorist cell shuts down the electrical grid, internet and other utilities in the west? What if some tyrant uses nukes, dirty bombs, chemical, or biological weapons, which could make large parts of EU or the US inhabitable? *“The what-if”* list is endless. I am afraid that sooner or later, something really bad may happen, which will ruin our lives for good.

In the last century, it was a lot more difficult for any individual, a group of people, or even a country to develop something that would cause a huge crisis in large areas of the world. It was more unthinkable for anyone to do something totally crazy like that, but now the gloves are off, and the perception of something catastrophic happening is a lot greater. Today with the help of computers and the internet, an individual can cause a lot more harm than what was possible in the past.

Why not let really dedicated professionals come up with plans for our MOST important problems?

Main point

If we could start afresh, would we choose this same global governing system that we have now? Or do you think that we will be able to save the world from the constant turmoil, uncertainty and wars by trying to fix it a little bit here and there?

Don't underestimate the power of an idea whose time has come.

The basic idea of this plan is:

We must reform the United Nations to become the world leader that it was meant to be. This plan provides the solutions to these three dilemmas:

1. ***How do we gently force all the countries of the world to support the UN reform?***
2. ***How do we get the people and media to support this movement?***

3. *How do we fund this movement by getting free money?*

These three ideas are the KEY to this plan, and something different that has not been tried together before.

IMPORTANT: When I talk about giving the UN more power, or talk about a one-world government, understandably many people may fear that some group of people will end up seizing powers in the UN and enslaving us all. **That is a valid fear, but as you read on, you will realize that this plan is different, and there's NO WAY that any group of people, or a country(ies) could overtake the New United Nations (NUN).**

There will be multiple internal and external safeguards to make sure that there could never be any kind of power grab, and the NUN cannot be misused by any individuals, group, or country for their benefit. Also, all the decisions will be made according to NUN's new values and ethics.

The New United Nations will be staffed by a new kind of people who work without any partisanship, politics or religion. It will be governed by totally new rules, regulations, and most importantly, by **NEW COMMON SENSE VALUES AND ETHICS.**

The NUN will create a new IMPARTIAL, VALUE and RULE-BASED world governing system!

The NUN will govern only the **MAJOR** worldwide issues, like wars, getting rid of tyrants, human rights issues, etc. The NUN will not meddle with individual countries' internal matters.

If the UN is reformed the right way, sovereign nations will be more free and independent than what they are now.

Are European nations independent? No, they are not. Under the New United Nations the EU could cease to exist as it is now. It could become just an economic free zone between the European countries.

NATO would become a useless relic of the past. Treaty obligations tie the U.S. to come to the defense of 67 different countries around the world, going well beyond

the 29-member NATO alliance. All these treaties, and bilateral defense agreements would be history.

Nationalist, you don't have to worry because under the NUN all the nations in the world would be MORE free than before, to do as they please. Countries could concentrate on building their societies, instead of maintaining costly militaries and unnecessary alliances. Every sovereign nation's independence would be sacred and respected.

NUN MANDATE #1: The NUN would have a mandate to defend any country in the world against any internal or external attack. How could any nation afford to attack another nation, if that would mean that they are starting a war against the whole world? **All wars stop right here!**

Michael Møller, director-general of the United Nations Geneva office said. ***"There isn't a single one of these [global] problems that can be solved by a single actor. We have to do it together; otherwise, we shall all die together."***

1. How can we achieve this UN reform?

From the brink of World War to the brink of World Peace with e-mails.

By starting a massive email and social media campaign, in which people around the world are instructed to email all of their current and future city, county, state and national elected representatives something like this:

This campaign is not a one-off, but we must keep this pressure on them with emails, the social media, and also the mainstream media for long enough, then sooner or later, all politicians from the local city level to the president will be FORCED to get behind the idea of the UN reform. **Surely then, it's only a matter of time before the UN reform becomes a reality.**

One great point is that the people around the world can conduct this revolution FROM THE COMFORT OF THEIR OWN HOMES, with very little effort, and with practically no cost involved. **How could any decent person say no to this?** Say no to sending a few repeat emails and social media posts a week!

The people who want to get more involved in this movement, and there will be millions of those; they can volunteer by printing posters, creating FB groups, posting lists of all the political candidates and their email addresses and social media pages, and promoting this campaign in many different ways.

The best part is that the politicians won't have to do that much either. All they would have to do is to declare on their social media that they will support the UN reform and then vote for it when the time comes. Minimal effort required!

IMPORTANT: The beauty of this plan is that it gives the politicians an **EXCUSE** to say; ***"Sorry my political party, sorry military machine, sorry big money, sorry lobbyist... I realize that you might be against the UN reform, but I am FORCED by my People to support the UN reform. If I don't support it, I will not get elected/re-elected."***

Just think about how easily the above stars could energize their friends, fan base, and the media to support this idea with a few comments about it on social media.

Then other celebrities around the world would follow suit and spread the word to their fans.

A list of accounts with the highest number of followers in Instagram: Cristiano Ronaldo 517M, Justin Bieber 455M, Ariana Grande 429M, Selena Gomez 425M, Taylor Swift 361M, Dwayne Johnson 342M, Katy Perry 338M, Kylie Jenner 333M, Rihanna Music 332M, Kim Kardashian 319M. Look at those numbers! How easily these celebrities could spread this idea. **The power of social media!**

For example, if just these 10 above-mentioned celebrities would together support this idea and they would get just 200 million of their followers to also support it. If those 200 million people would each get just a few of their friends also to support the UN reform, and so on. **That would be one to two billion supporters, in no time!**

Again, the best part is that these celebrities would not have to do that much to get this movement rolling.

All they would have to do is to encourage their fans to start sending emails and social media posts to their elected officials. The celebrities could do this with a few comments on different media. **How could any decent celebrity say no to this?**

They could approach philanthropist billionaires, and charitable trust with this idea of reforming the UN and ask for donations for this cause.

Advertising and peace organizations around the world could use this movement for fundraising and then promote it locally.

Because the advertising and peace organizations would get tens of millions of dollars for running this movement, **this would give these organizations an INCENTIVE to get involved in this movement.**

If anybody, the advertising companies should be able to sell this idea to charitable trusts and organizations!

Once we get some high-caliber celebrities, and other influential people and organizations on board, and then they explain what this movement is all about, to the super-rich philanthropists, and different foundations and businesses, the money will pour in. Who would say no to an opportunity to be part of something this crucial for the world and humankind?

People are sick and tired of wars, turmoil, and constant uncertainty. People in every country are fed up and disgusted with their politicians and the ineffective UN. They

- The goal is that ultimately within the next 30 years, only the NUN will have major armed forces.

- The NUN will have a mandate to take a leading role over the world's' nuclear, chemical and biological arms reduction programs.
- The UN Security Council, veto rights, and all similar unfair power structures will be abolished.
- **The NUN will have the power and mandate** to resolve any armed conflicts, stop wars, and to get rid of, by force if necessary any tyrants in the world who hurt their fellow citizens.
- The NUN will also take a leading role in combating terrorism with the help of member nations.
- The NUN will make rules and laws as to how every nation must treat its citizens. Basic human rights for all!
- The NUN will govern only on MAJOR international issues. It will NOT meddle with sovereign nation's internal issues!
- The NUN will also take a leading role in major natural catastrophes.

The big powerful nations of the world have been trying to solve the world's problems with minimal results, **simply because they never try to solve anything but only work to PROTECT THEIR OWN INTERESTS!**

President Trump put this very nicely in 2017 in Vietnam when he said to the other world leaders; *"I will always put America first, as I expect you to put your country first."* **What if we all would put what's fair and good for the common good, and the world first?** WOW, what a novel concept!

Because every nation on earth does put their own nation's interest first; that is the very reason why nothing major ever gets resolved. **This is the cyst of all the major international problems we have.**

In the last century and before it was more acceptable in the world that the nations of the world took care of their own problems because we weren't so intertwined, and close to each other. Nowadays, because of the internet, fast travel, commerce between nations, and having shared challenges, we truly are like one big global family.

Because we are one global family, we must start governing the world accordingly.

When it comes to the major issues that we collectively face, we must have **one centralized power** that will deal with them without politics, partisanship, or religions. To be able to solve the critical issues the world faces, we must work as a global family that we are.

Here is what former Prime Minister of Australia **Kevin Rudd** said about the UN reform: *"I remain a life-long UN supporter, advocate and optimist. But the time for deep UN reform is now. Otherwise, the UN will, in the decades ahead, not die, but quietly fade away, the facade of a once-grand building but where, on closer inspection, little of substance actually happens anymore. And that would be an avoidable tragedy for us all, large states and in particular small, signaling the end of what remains a core pillar of our post-world order."*

Also, **Michael Møller**, director-general of the United Nations Geneva office is for the reform. He was asked: **Secretary-General António Guterres has strongly defended the need for reform within the U.N. What specifically needs to change?**

Michael Møller replied. *"Pretty much everything. This is an organization created 70 years ago that has not entirely kept pace with rapid changes, realities, and big existential challenges such as climate change, migration, and health. We have to change our peace and security mechanisms, the way we do development, our internal management, and back-office functions."*

"There isn't a single one of these [global] problems that can be solved by a single actor. We have to do it together; otherwise, we shall all die together."

He also said, *"We have to return to a rules-based world with ethics and moral codes that we can agree to. They do not have to be those that were agreed upon 70 years ago, because the world is changing, and we have to change with it."*

As growing concerns over climate change, human rights abuses, and mass migration intensify pressure for U.N. reform, Michael Møller, director-general of its Geneva office in Switzerland, insists that multilateralism is all the more vital.

Many people are pointing out the fact that the UN is in danger of becoming irrelevant. The time to reform the UN is NOW.

Below is a more detailed explanation of the direction of how the UN could be reformed

- **Every nation in the world is allowed to make its own rules and laws** regarding political views, governing systems, official religions, etc. But the NUN will create detailed rules and laws about how all the countries of the world must treat their citizens.

Some of the human rights: equality before the law, no discrimination, innocent until proven guilty, freedom of movement, right to own things, freedom of opinion, right to vote, etc. The NUN would also govern these issues; child labor, girls' school issues, forced religious teachings, forced marriage, genital mutilation, economic slavery, and other similar issues, which all should be human rights for every person.

Every country is obligated to provide a dignified life, and the basic needs to its people. Such as basic education and basic healthcare, food and shelter, etc. (What basic means varies from country to country depending on how poor the country is. These services don't have to be 100% free, but affordable enough so that people can afford them, and the poorest of the poor people would get them for free.) Also, "basic needs" means a different level of help depending on the country. "Basic needs" in Finland are totally different than in

impoverished countries. Of course, as these countries get wealthier, then these basic services will improve as well.

If a country is too poor to take care of its citizens, then the NUN is obligated to help that country until it is capable of taking care of its people.

The lack of basic necessities in many poor countries is not because of the lack of money, but because the leaders of these countries steal the money and often steal foreign aid. The NUN will have a mandate to get rid of tyrants that steal aid, or monies that belong to these nations.

- **The NUN will be the world's police.** It will deal with any situation with a neutral stance and common sense values. The NUN will be obligated to protect every member nation from any violent attack from another country. Once the attack has been stopped, the leaders, and generals of the attacking country will be removed, and tried in the International Courts. **This will practically end all the wars the very moment this law becomes effective.**
- If a person starts shooting a gun from his apartment balcony, or beats his family, **the local police have the absolute power and mandate** to remove that person who is a danger to his family, or fellow citizens. If parents starve their children, they will be prosecuted for it. **Why are the leaders of many countries not governed by the same law as its citizens are?**
- The NUN will be obligated by law, by any means necessary to get rid of any world leaders, political party, religious group, terrorist group or armed forces, which for example starves, imprisons people for political, LGBT, religious reasons, or kills or mistreats their people in any way. **This law will stop people's suppression around the world.**
- The NUN will take a leading role in worldwide arms reduction. The goal is that in about 20 to 30 years there are no more nuclear, chemical or biological arms in the world.
- Even though the US, Russia, China, and some other small "rebellious" countries will not give up their armed forces for a long time to come, but **ONLY THE NUN HAS THE RIGHT TO DECLARE WAR AGAINST A NATION OR A GROUP OF PEOPLE.** Of course, every nation has the right to defend itself against any attack, and the NUN is obligated to help them.

- **No individuals or groups in the NUN can start any armed operations on their own. All sanctions, armed responses or peacekeeping missions will be voted on by all the member nations.**
- If one of these big countries would start military action against another nation, or against their own people, then they would be declaring war against EVERY member nation in the NUN. This kind of situation, of course, would be a very complicated issue to deal with, but I am sure that isolating this country, with very severe and immediate economic sanctions, and penalties would bring this country back in line.

After the NUN is in power, it will be very unlikely for anything like this to happen. Just think about it; how could any country, regardless of how powerful it is, survive if the whole world is against it? **There is no way that any major country would be stupid enough to start hostilities against the whole united world.**

Also, in the future, people around the world would understand that they are part of the solution, and they should stop traveling to, and buying anything from a country that is causing problems. No country could afford to be isolated.

Of course, many countries with major armed forces will be hesitant to give up their arms but in the future, as they realize that the peaceful world is also much better for them, they will start reducing their arms by not buying new arms as the old ones get decommissioned.

When the NUN is in charge, then most of the smaller countries will soon realize that they don't need a big military force anymore. They will have small armed forces for protecting themselves against possible riots, terrorism, national guard, etc. By having small armed forces they can save a lot of money.

Today many tyrants know that the other nations cannot do anything to them, and they keep on starving and killing their own people and putting innocent people in prisons. Other countries scold them, but that's about it.

Most likely this will work out so that the NUN will never have to use any military powers because the NUN mandates, and laws regarding wars will work as a deterrent.

In the future, no sane leader of a country would start a war, because **there is NO way they could get away with it**. The new laws will dictate that the leaders of a rebellious country and their generals will end up in a prison.

These laws will be strictly enforced. If any country is not willing to obey them, then the NUN can fine, or place a sanction on this country, or on its leaders. 

If any nation would stay outside, they would soon feel very isolated. And sooner or later, the citizens in these countries would pressure the leaders to join. People around the world could stop traveling to and buying things from that country. There are many gentle ways to force them to join in. In a few years, these nations would start seeing that the peaceful world is also much more beneficial for them than the old world order. Eventually, all would join in, for sure.

Will the NUN use boycotts?

Yes, once We The People force the UN reform, that will make people realize that **We the People can pretty much rule the world with our combined power.**

Today most people are just too busy to get involved in boycotts, and they don't believe in their power, but the UN reform will prove and show that We The People have the power.

People will realize that boycotts are much more effective than riots, which usually cause more harm than good.

The NUN may use armed forces; many peace activists are against using violence

I understand these activists, and I would like to resolve ALL the problems in the world with talk, but what if a talk is not working?

If there is a crazy tyrant who is threatening the world, or his own people's lives, we may have to use violence to get rid of him. Wouldn't you want someone to help you, if it were your family's life that was in danger?

Most pacifists would be screaming for police to shoot an intruder who is trying to kill their family. When a crime happens to you or a loved one you do want to have someone to come rescue with a gun in their hand. It's so easy to be against violence when you are safely far from danger, but when you must live through it yourself, you will think differently.

According to Wikipedia, The United States imposed the first sanctions against South Korea in the 1950s. The UN Security Council has passed several resolutions since North Korea's first nuclear test in 2006. **We have been playing this very dangerous nuclear game with North Korea since 2006!**

This is the main problem with our current system. We don't end these situations at the beginning and end up letting them go on for tens of years. The reason for this is that only the US has had the power to force North Korea to stop testing, but the US presidents haven't done anything because **they are more concerned about their popularity numbers, and their legacy than anything else**. They know that, if they try to do something, the situation may turn into a huge mess, and that could ruin their legacy, which is why they have stayed clear of North Korea.

One big hindrance for peace in North-Korea has also been this: A total of 49 countries violated United Nations sanctions on North Korea to varying degrees between March 2014 and September 2017, the Institute for Science and International Security said. That includes North Korea's top trading partner, China, as well as Germany, Brazil, India, and France. Meanwhile, Russia, among others, has been shipping "illegal goods" to North Korea as of late.

The point is that the North Korean situation would have been resolved a long time ago if countries and companies had not violated the sanctions. All these years the people of North Korea have been suffering, while the top brass lives in luxury. There are ships full of whiskey and other luxury items sailing towards NK all the time.

The NUN would act immediately when there is any violation of the new international laws. The NUN would have the power to **severely penalize** any company or a country that violates any sanctions. By punishing a few companies so severely that they

would almost go out of business other companies would take notice and see this as a deterrent.

Potentially the current situation in North Korea could lead to a nuclear war, and nobody seems to care. Should that happen, our comfortable lives as we know it could be over. The whole world could tailspin into a deep recession, which would lead to all kinds of upheaval. Mass unemployment, huge numbers of refugees, and all this would lead to chaos all around the world.

I am sure that it's only a matter of time before one could make a small electronic bomb in his garage that could take out the power grid of a small city. Artificial intelligence is developing fast. AI could bring all kinds of harmful means to terrorists and rogue nations. Even home computers could soon be powerful enough that we can make biological and chemical weapons in our garages. One can easily buy or build an all-terrain mini tank or a drone, mount a machine gun on it and then control it from a distance. Bad people can cause a lot of havoc with these new inventions.

How are we going to stop these threats? Most truly dangerous hackers and terrorists operate from a country that turns a blind eye to them. For example, in 2021 North Korea state sponsored hackers stole close to \$500 in crypto currencies. Many hacker groups that have caused a lot of havoc in the west operate from Russia. The Russian government knows them, and most likely gets a cut from their proceeds. The NUN could force these nations to get rid of these hacking groups.

The NUN could help to get rid of these threats, if it had a mandate, laws and means to do it. Maybe some of these things must be outlawed worldwide? The point is that we MUST clean the world out of wars, tyrants, dangerous state-sponsored hackers, and physical and cyber terrorism NOW before it's too late. We must create a peaceful world NOW to avoid disaster.

As we all have seen, the way the world is now being governed will lead only to more chaos, because our current leaders always play power games and try to benefit from these crises. **Nowadays nothing is ever being solved so that it is good for the world and humankind**, but so that political parties, companies or countries will benefit from these problems.

The world now is like a rat-infested housing complex; you will never get rid of the rats little by little; you must do a major clean up. After that, it will be a lot easier to keep it clean.

**Time is ticking away fast.... our leaders will wake up when it's too late.

Unfortunately, we currently live in a world, in which sometimes violence is the answer. **But of course, the NUN will always use all available peaceful means first, and the armed response is the last resort.**

How much suffering do we have in the world today?

The consequences of OUR inaction of not being able to prevent and stop wars are incredibly dreadful. There are 11 official wars and 8 active military conflicts recognized by the United States. There are also other violent conflicts involving 64 countries and 576 militias and separatist groups. There are close to a hundred million refugees. Just stop to think that there are about 200 countries in the world

and at least 64 of them have violent conflicts! Things are not getting better but much worse as time goes on.

US Maj. General Smedley Butler wrote in 1935: "*War is a racket.*" "Only a small 'inside' group knows what it is about. It is conducted for the benefit of the very few, at the expense of the very many. Out of war a few people make huge fortunes."

On top of wars, think about the possible climate change, animal extinction, pollution, and other environmental catastrophes, and last but not certainly the least worrisome problem; the total global debt crisis that is going to hit the fan sooner or later. There's nothing but suffering in the world.

Can you even imagine what will happen when the world's economic machine grinds to a very painful halt?

When there is mass unemployment around the world, and refugees and immigrants are willing to work for less money. That will lead to racial/civil wars within nations, and ultimately to wars between nations, and to a total chaos. You really think that our current UN, countries, and politicians around the world are capable of stopping this utter chaos that is coming our direction? **No, they are not!**

The Old World Order is slowly but surely being dismantled by war mongers, big money, hackers, terrorism, and unfriendly national powers. We are now living in the New World Disorder.

Whose values will govern the world?

Tony Blair said. "*The single biggest threat to the west is that we don't understand that the 21st century will be a battle about values, whose values will govern the world?*"

Whose values do you want to live by? And more importantly, by what values do you want to govern the world; American, Chinese, European or **common sense, down to earth, IMPARTIAL, non-religious and non-political values? Values that are based on the common good for the people, nature, businesses, nations, and the whole world?**

There is another way, but are we smart enough to take it? Who will have the custodianship of the world?

Who will pay for the UN reform?

There could be a UN reform fee that all the UN member nations would pay according to their Gross National Product. I am confident that the money will not be a problem. Rich countries, businesses, rich people, and even ordinary people could all make donations to the UN reform fund.

When it comes to running the NUN, it will be completely streamlined. It has grown to a bloated beast with no teeth. All unnecessary departments and overlaps will be cut out. In this day and age, every nation should be able to find English speaking delegates to send to the NUN. There is a tremendous amount of waste in translations. Cutting some of the cost of running the NUN off could save the NUN as much as it cost to reform it. And no matter how significant the cost of reforming it will be, it will be worth it.

How is the NUN going deal with terrorism?

It will take a leading role in combating terrorism. The NUN is obligated to help any nation that is being attacked by any large group of terrorists, whether they come from outside or inside of that country.

Now in some countries, the leaders don't care about cleaning the terrorist out, because the uncertainty and constant fear of terrorism keeps the citizens' minds preoccupied with the fear of terrorism. Meanwhile, the army generals get kickbacks from arms manufacturers, and the rulers can empty the coffers of the country. If you want to know why something is the way it is, look who is making money with the situation. Follow the money!

There will be a mandate that every country must squash any terrorism once they know about it. If they are not capable of doing it, then the NUN will come to their aid. One major difference with the current system will be that **any terrorism or armed conflict is going to be dealt with immediately**. Now we wait for years to see how they develop, while thousands of people get killed and huge numbers of people are displaced. If a country cannot stop the terrorist, then the NUN will go in with massive enough force to stop them on their tracks before it gets out of hand.

On the NUN's watch, NO tyrant or country will get away with these things anymore.

How is the NUN going to deal with the refugees?

Any country can take as many refugees from any part of the world as they want, but when it comes to illegal refugees, as we have seen happening in Europe, the NUN will be part of the solution.

One of the most important points is that any mass exodus is going to be dealt with immediately. For example, if people of a country must get out because of a war then the NUN will pay, help build, and maintain as many refugee camps near the border of that country as it takes to house ALL the refugees. So, when the situation clears, it will be easy for people to return back to their own country. The refugees are NOT allowed to start a mass exodus. Eventually, they will return to their own country.

While war will be eradicated by the NUN, there may be natural disasters, famine, etc. that could create mass refugees. These issues will also be swiftly dealt with by the NUN. All the UN member nations will pay for these operations.

What if the NUN starts meddling with the internal issues of its member countries?

That will be prohibited by internal laws of the NUN. There will be very clear laws and regulations as to what the NUN can and cannot do. All the member nations will vote on these laws.

The NUN may have to enforce laws on a sovereign nation in some instances. For example, let's say that we realize that Brazil's rainforest really are the lungs of the earth, and they must stop cutting it down. Whatever the excuses Brazil may use, it's not going to be enough to justify that we jeopardize the well being of the world. This is such a huge issue for the whole world that if the Brazilian government is not able, or willing to stop the deforestation, then the NUN must go to Brazil and stop it. Or better yet, the NUN will help Brazil to stop it.

In cases like this, when rainforest, and other HUGE areas of the land are cleared for agriculture they are mostly done by big greedy multinational corporations. This happens at an ever-increasing speed in many countries around the world. Soybean fields in South America are one big culprit. They always have the same excuse; people need food. But that's a lie. If the governments in those counties would be fair with their working class, and businesses would pay living wages, the people would have enough money to buy food. It's the greedy big money and corrupt rulers who are the problem.

When it comes to meddling with the member nations, the **European Union is the opposite of what the NUN will be.** The EU controls almost everything in the member countries. The EU even had a law that Cucumbers cannot be too crooked. That led to huge waste because a big part of the harvest had to be thrown out. That law was repealed, but every year the EU keeps on adding new totally useless laws and rules.

Many people are against centralizing power into one institution

We need to centralize the MAJOR decisions about the world wide issues to one neutral power. People are afraid of this because in the past this has led to dictatorships; like it did with Hitler, Mao, and Stalin. But it's impossible that the NUN would become a police state or dictatorship. Those days are long gone, but people still have this knee jerk reaction whenever a centralized world power comes up.

The European Union, and the United States are centralized powers, and most people are okay with them. All decisions will be made for the good of the world, **by people who are professionals in their field of work.** Just stop to think about that for a moment; the NUN will have professional staff, not big ego, narcissistic politicians who rarely know nothing but how to play political games.

What is your warning to the tyrants of the world?

When the new laws become effective in the NUN, then there is no longer a possibility for any tyrants to get "a golden handshake" and comfortable retirement. After the gavel hits the desk in the UN headquarters and the NUN is born, then it will be obligated to remove and prosecute these tyrants, police, and army leaders.

When the NUN takes over an unruly country, its citizens will feel safe to start giving testimony on all kinds of old crimes. Lower-ranking people will be promised plea deals if they can implicate the higher-ups. The NUN will mainly go after the higher-level government, police, and armed forces leaders. Lower-ranking members were in most cases ordered by their superiors to commit these crimes.

Murder never gets old. Even old crimes will be investigated and already retired ex-tyrants and army chiefs are not going to feel safe. There will not be bail. These tyrants and generals will be waiting for their trial in the same prisons they threw their opponents and countless innocent people. All their ill-gained property will be confiscated, and their bank accounts will be frozen. Even the leaders and army

chiefs' families and close friends and business partners' properties will be confiscated if they are determined to be illegally acquired.

All unexplainable wealth will be confiscated. Many accountants, close friends, and lower-ranking people will aid the investigations in finding all the stolen wealth to save their own skin. It will be very easy to find the hidden bank accounts and to prove these financial crimes.

How should independence issues be handled?

I think it would **be very healing for the world** if areas of some countries that have been forcefully taken could become independent or join their original motherland. The NUN will come up with the rules and laws regarding all the border and independence movement issues. These laws will be voted in the NUN so that every nation is part of putting these laws together. International Courts will hear these cases, and the NUN will enforce them.

These laws must be based on common sense, for example, was the area taken by force in a war? How long ago? How well has this area been integrated into the current country? Would break off cause major upheaval to the people who live there? Do the people who live in that area want to leave the current country, or is it just some small group of people who want that? Is it an ethnic group that wants to be independent? What are the grounds for independence?

I would think that the start of World War I could serve as a good cut-off point because it was a major war that affected most of the nations in the world. (WWI was 100 years ago, maybe that's a convenient cut-off point?) If some area was taken away before that, it's now part of the current nation, but of course, there could be some special cases and any group of people could take their case to the International Courts.

What will happen, if we don't reform the UN?

This may give you some idea of it: China's president said in a speech in October 2017 that China's goal is to tighten the armed forces, and civilian life more together; sounds bad whatever that means. Their goal is to be the world leader and to have a world-class armed force between the years 2035-2050. This means that the rest of the world must keep up with China's arm race.

World military expenditure reached an all-time high of \$2.1 trillion in 2021, the seventh consecutive year that spending increased. **TRILLIONS EVERY YEAR.** During the last 33 years we have spent close to \$50 trillion (inflation adjusted to 2020 dollars) on the military around the world.

This figure does not cover taking care of wounded veterans, rebuilding of war-torn areas, etc. Total cost of wars is several times that 50 trillion. The **cost of human suffering is unimaginable!**

Had we spent some of that money on health research, we may have found a cure for many of the illnesses that now ravage us! But no, we are totally stupid and let our leaders and generals play their violent war games. That's what wars are for them, just games.

I understand them. If I were a fireman, or a police SWAT team member and I train for years for all kinds of situations, I want to put my skills to use. I want fires, or I want a hostage situation in which I get to shoot my gun, even though it may mean that people die. This is human nature, but we have evolved enough that we should be able to control our impulses. It's not too long when spanking your kids was totally fine and even expected, but most of us have grown out of that practice.

There's the big money who would say, "making arms, maintaining militaries, wars and rebuilding countries after all the destruction creates work and profits." Yes, that's true, but I am sure that, if we would stop wars and reduce arms, the money that is invested in arms would find other much more beneficial industries, like medicine.

The US is starting a Space Force. India and Pakistan are on the brink of war. Russia and Ukraine are fighting. China is flexing its arms all over the world. Any of these conflicts could easily get out of control and cause unforeseen damage. **We must stop this utter craziness before it's too late!**

Could all this be because our leaders can hold on to power much easier when times are uncertain, and the constant fear of war is present? In the US, the arms lobby is very powerful. Normally Republicans and Democrats hardly ever agree on any issues, but not so surprisingly most wars they agree on. Could this be because they both are so heavily lobbied on by arms manufacturers?

If we add the cost of all wars, armed conflicts, freedom fighting, national guards, armies, police force, private guards, I am quite confident to say that close to 40% of

all the money we have in the world goes to these areas. And if we count the cost of rebuilding bombed-out countries, hospitalization of wounded people, the cost of the war machine is much higher.

The United States alone has spent nearly \$6 trillion on wars that directly contributed to the deaths of around 500,000 people since the 9/11 attacks of 2001. This has created an unfathomable amount of human suffering, on which we cannot put any price.

It really is beyond all my imagination that in this century we are still fearful of each other and spend a HUGE amount of money on arms and wars. I would understand this kind of thinking, if we were living in the 1800s, but not today. Again, it's not the people of the US, Russia or China who want war and turmoil, it's the leaders of these countries!

Our leaders will wake up when a major war breaks out, or when the rising sea level starts washing the toes of the Statue of Liberty in New York. Then they will start blaming the old administrations for these problems. Even then, they will not be able to reach any meaningful remedies.

What kind of people will the NUN draw to itself?

I am sure that there already are a lot of good, dedicated people in the UN, but many people want to work there just for advancing their careers. The UN has its share of power-hungry, big ego, narcissistic people who are there for the wrong reason. These people enjoy constant crisis and upheaval. They love to be in the limelight, pretending to be solving yet another crisis. They never do resolve anything but just bandage it for the moment. I don't blame the current UN personnel. I am sure that many of them are trying their best under the rules and regulations that are now in place.

When we set up the new governing model in the NUN, in which high values, morals, and ethics govern every decision that is being made.

This is an essential part of the UN reform. The NUN will draw a different breed of people than it did before.

In every government around the world, and in the UN, there already are thousands of these people who feel that working for the people is their calling. I call them invisible

gray mass. They are the core of any workforce that keeps things together, but they never get the credit for it. In politics or in business, it's the loudmouth, big ego leaders who steal the glory that these people should have.

This invisible gray mass would be willing to work for free for the NUN because they are dedicated to the well-being of the world. In the NUN, they will be properly compensated, and they will get the glory for running the NUN. These people can have their own political and religious views, but they will be smart enough that they will leave them at the coat check when they start making decisions in the NUN. This is what kind of people the NUN will draw to its doors.

Also most importantly, every position in the NUN will be filled with a person who is professional in that field of work. Wow, what a novel concept.

Would a big ego, narcissistic, and often even psychopath type of politician be drawn or thrive in an environment, in which high morals and ethics and rules are faithfully respected? I don't think so! **The NUN will draw people who are deeply concerned about the state of the world. Honest and diligent servants of We the People!**

Therefore I am very confident that getting the UN reformed would not be as difficult task as it may seem to some people. **With super dedicated people, who respect the new values and ethics, it will be a breeze.**

Just think about what kind of energy this would create in the NUN! The huge issues that we now argue about for years without getting any meaningful results would be resolved in a few meetings. As we start reforming the UN, we must also reform our own lives, neighborhoods, cities, and countries. Then, and only then, we can say that we have a true WORLD PEACE and freedom. We just cannot expect the NUN or our politicians to take care of fixing all the world's problems, **we MUST be a BIG part of the solution, and we must be willing to DO OUR PART in reforming our own lives, families, and neighborhoods!**

The opposite is true; they would gain tremendous value from it. Only the leaders of rogue countries that mistreat their citizens would feel the negative consequences.

- All different ethnic groups from Rohingyas in Myanmar to Kurds in Syria and Chinese Uighurs, and many other oppressed groups of people would finally find peace, freedom and dignified life.
- Most nations could start using most of the money that now goes to armed forces, for other more important matters.
- The NUN will be equal for all nations.
- No more bullying in the UN. No more vote-buying etc.
- We can finally get a consensus and agreement on many pressing global issues, such as global warming, pollution issues, animal and nature protection.
- The NUN will have the means to make sure that all the nations adhere to the new laws and regulations.
- The whole world, and all the people would start living in peace, helping each other; this planet would be the paradise that it was meant to be!

How could the UN afford to help all the struggling nations of the world to feed, provide shelter, basic health care, and education for all?

Of course, it could not do it overnight. Most impoverished nations have inefficient, corrupt, and greedy leadership. In many cases, a country could take care of its people on its own, if the leaders would not steal most of the money. There are countless countries that have enough money to take care of their citizens, but the money doesn't trickle down to the people.

The aid that is given to many poor nations might alone be enough to take care of these people, if it went where it was supposed to go. Money to help impoverished countries is already there, but it's not going to the right addresses.

Taking care of the people doesn't mean that some poor African nations must provide a three-bedroom house, with satellite TV, hot water and air-conditioning, the free university, and healthcare for all. To start with we are talking about providing very basic conditions to the poorest countries' citizens. Then these countries keep on improving people's conditions as they get wealthier.

Education is a HUGE part of the NUN future vision

One way we can ensure that every new generation will make this world even better, is by the right kind of education. We must create a shared world identity, a mental picture - image of ourselves being human beings of the world. Now we tend to see ourselves through the prism of our national identity. I am a Finn. I don't see myself as a human being living in the world, who was born in Finland.

We must create a new identity image of ourselves that we all are children of the world, brothers and sisters, who happen to live in different parts of the world. We must unite behind shared core values; individual freedom, world peace, basic human rights, and a healthy world.

As an example you can see a strong shared identity in many religious groups, tribes, national movements, and political parties. Now we must expand our views of who we all really are first; a human tribe, and that we have a shared goal and dream.

If we have collective will on individual and national levels that treasures our shared core values, then the world will always have freedom, peace, harmony, and good will for all.

The only way to do this is by global education. We must prove to the people that this view is much more beneficial for them and for the whole world, than the current mess we live in. Then they will adopt it more readily.

You can take a young mind and mold it any which way you want. You can turn it into a US hating communist, a cutthroat capitalist, a religious zealot who wants to destroy other religions, a terrorist, or anything in between. Why not teach something good? Why not teach our kids to wage peace instead of war?

We should teach our children that yes, money is important and being a capitalist is fine, if you don't let your greediness to own you. If you are greedy, then nothing will ever be enough. If you let greediness own you, you become an empty shell. You lose most of your meaningful emotions that make you human. When greediness drives you, cold, material, dead objects become your goal. Even your partner, children and friends become objects, and measure of your success; they are all just trophies.

The NUN will create a new curriculum for schools that countries around the world can adapt to fit their own needs for free. **This is a voluntary program.** Every country can choose their own education system, but by designing one good quality, and free program, especially poorer nations can save a lot of money, and they will get a much better program, than the sub-standard school programs that most poor countries currently use.

As I write this, in Finland an education minister is very worried about young students not learning enough, and he wants to start mandatory preschool education at three years of age. This is a typical politicians' knee jerk reaction; make the children study longer and harder.

If there is an increased youth crime. Politicians would recommend building more prisons. Generals will recommend whipping them in shape in the army. Clergymen will recommend prayer in church.

This is pretty much how today's societies are run. Nothing is ever solved but our leaders want fast bandage solutions in each problem. Delinquent youths are a symptom. The cause is what we must find and remedy. The cause could be that we live in sick societies, and we teach kids wrong values, and we really don't care about them.

Our politicians don't want to rock the boat. They just want to have band aid remedies. They don't stop to think that maybe the real reason why kids don't want to learn is the old school system, or that youths are delinquent because our societies are sick. Maybe the schools are boring, and they teach kids just to be cogs of the wheels in society. Maybe schools don't want to teach the kids how to find their own calling? Maybe they are brainwashing kids to be the next generation of "slaves"? In many cases our children don't get good neutral education, they get societal, religious, or political indoctrination. **Is that how we should bring up our children?** We really cannot do better for them?

Maybe the remedy for issues like this is to create a totally new kind of society with new values and ambitions? That starts with the right kind of education.

This NUNs "good life" curriculum will concentrate on teaching about self-confidence, self-worth, good common sense values, how to take care of the world, nature, animals, respect your elders, teachers, other people's religions or sexual preferences, and lifestyles, the importance of good manners and presentation skills, personal responsibility, importance of personal integrity, honor, and honesty, responsibility, self-reliance, health, exercise, how not to get involved with alcohol, drugs, crime, or wrong people and no bullying. How to find your own path in life. What is important in life? How to deal with one's emotions and feelings. How to find happiness. In other words, teach youngsters how to be confident in themselves and how to live a good, happy and healthy life.

Life skills and a good value system are important bases for a successful life. When young people are taught these kinds of skills, they are much less likely to end up as criminals, addicts, or unemployed. If children have these skills down, then they will be more successful and happier regardless of what their education level or profession is. They will also understand that a good overall education is important, and they will study much harder on their own, without any force, which usually kills any desire to learn in the first place.

If you will just stop to think about your own life for a moment. **How would your life have been, if you had an opportunity to study in a school where you were taught the above skills?** If you would have learned to like or even love yourself, you would be fearless in front of other people, you would have solid self-confidence, and you would have a high degree of self-worth, you would have kept your body and mind healthy, you would have had enough self-confidence to follow your own path and dreams, you would have not stayed in toxic relationships, and would not have abused drugs or alcohol? **How would your life be now?** At least mine would have been more exciting, freer, interesting, healthier, and probably even more successful in many different ways.

If we all could get a little bit closer to our full potential, our lives would be much more meaningful. This world would be a paradise for us.

Having these learnable skills is how you have a happy, content, and successful life.

Have you ever met a genuinely happy/content person who has fears, is overly shy, doesn't have self-confidence, hates him or herself. No, you have not! The same goes for a person who is greedy, selfish, envious, bad, criminal, mean, and violent. It's impossible to be happy/content and have any of the aforementioned traits.

We do need to learn the basics of the regular school curriculum, but today all the knowledge we will ever need is on our phones and computers. This is why we don't anymore need to learn a lot of dry facts.

In the future more and more computers, robots and AI will be doing a lot of our work, so we don't have to know many of the skills that were important a few years ago.

It is more important to teach our kids to enjoy lifelong self-learning and to give them the tools to find their own path, and also encourage gifted kids to continue studying.

Today's youth are VERY critical for this idea to succeed in the long run. We MUST get them excited and involved in this project. If they own this idea, then they will improve and support it as they grow older.

Different youth clubs and organizations are an important part of education. We must get the Scouts and all the other similar youth organizations around the world excited about this New Impartial, Value and Rule-Based World Order. Many of them are

already doing their part of educating the youth about good values, etc. Now we must support them even more.

We must design a new way to study and learn and teach our kids things that really matter.

Who should have the custodianship of the earth?

I firmly believe that after we reform the UN, and it will start making a huge difference in everybody's lives, we will realize how backward, non-free and inhumanely we have been living our lives.


